## Number of Maternal Transports


Summary

A maternal transport means an emergency transport to hospitals having advanced facilities for safety of both a mother and a fetus when their conditions get worse or are expected to be worse. Transporting a mother and a baby after delivery is called a postpartum transport.

The graph shows the number of maternal transports, postpartum transports and refusals.

Analysis

Postpartum transports has increased. It is difficult for small-scale hospitals to treat severe patients after giving birth, so they should get treatment in a hospital with advanced facilities before becoming severe.

Maternal transports possibly are rejected because of lack of empty beds, but the number of refusals has been decreasing. It might be influenced by decrease in number of deliveries.
